<b>Description</b>			
<p>Rake task "redmine:send_reminders" only send notifications for tickets assigned to users, if the ticket is assigned to a group, users in that group don't get notified. It's discussable but IMHO is a must for teamwork.</p> <p>In addition there's no way to especificy a group_id in the rake task.</p>
