<p>I followed this tutorial: http://www.redmine.org/projects/redmine/wiki/HowTo_simply_keep_Redmine_in_sync_with_GitHub</p> <p>The github hook calls the sys/fetch_changesets url but redmine does not fetch the new changes because the "git-fetch" command is never executed. When I add this code at the beginning of the "fetch_changesets" method in "models/repository/git.rb" it updates correctly.</p> <pre>system("cd #{self.url} && git fetch")</pre>

When the hook has been set up, I see "GET /sys/fetch_changesets?key=17...xv&id=sandbox HTTP/1.1" coming in when pressing GitHub's test button, but it does not cause an update of the local repository.
