<p><b>Description</b></p> <p>I have tried to create new page named "Ã£Æ'â€ Å£â€šÅ'Ã£Æ'Ë†" (means "test" in Japanese). But titleize method in wiki.rb returns "Ã£Æ'â€ \203\206Ã£â€šÅ'Ã£Æ'Ë†".
