I have tried to create new page named "ãÆ'†Ã£â€šÂ¹Ã£Æ'ˆ" (means "test" in Japanese). But titleize method in wiki.rb returns "ãÆ'†\203\206ã'¹Ã£Æ'ˆ". "\203\206" is garbage and makes wrong link URL wiki output.
