Example of issue with "Immediate" priority:  <pre>&lt;tr id="issue-706" class="hascontextmenu odd issue status-2 priority-7 created-by-me assigned-to-me"&gt;</pre> <i>priority-7</i> is wrong and should be one of <i>priority-{1,2,3,4,5}</i> .
