<div>Description</div> <p>The attached patch fixes a minor bug in User.allowed_to?</p> <p>Specifically, that method should return a boolean, but it actually sometimes returns a Role instead. This is because .detect is used when really .any? should be used.</p> <p>I am not aware of this causing any serious issues, but I noticed this during debugging and was greatly confused when allowed_to? suddenly returned a Role ;).</p>
