Macros won't work unless it is written on one line. For example:			
<pre>{{macro_list()}}</pre>			
Will work but:			
<pre>{{macro_list( )}}}</pre>			
Wont.			
Working on 1.2.X thru 1.4.X Not working on 2.1.2.			
This is important for macros that let you write on other languages and then translate it to wiki.
