## **Description**

I am unsure if the design was intended to be greedy, however for my macro I needed a lazy search since it took in a query string like: query=?show\_issues=1&show\_news=1&show\_documents=1&show\_files=1&show\_wiki\_edits=1. The current method matches "query=?show\_issues=1&show\_news=1&show\_documents=1&show\_files=1&show\_wiki\_edits": "1". When I look for options[:query] it returns nil. By using a lazy search, I get the intended result: "query":

"?show\_issues=1&show\_news=1&show\_documents=1&show\_files=1&show\_wiki\_edits=1"

Perhaps we should be able to specify if greedy or lazy?

I have attached my "quite simple" patch.
