Description

I believe that this is a major mistake, to load on the database changesets from DVCS. I can see that there may be a reason to store then if you are dealing with CVS/SVN but not with GIT, Bazaar and Mercurial.

This ends-up bloating the database with something that you can query locally. There is no reason not to use local data for that. This also enables working with big repositories, that otherwise would probably crash redmine during the "import phase" repositories went on before showing the latest revisions.
