When migrating from Trac the rake task selects users inconsistently because it only grabs users who have created a ticket, wiki page or attachment. This means some users are migrated with user name and email address and others are not. The script should use the contents of the session attribute table like:

INSERT INTO "session\_attribute" VALUES; INSERT INTO "session\_attribute" VALUES;

This could be done either as a supplemental query in the find\_or\_create\_user class or a separate migration task.
