Is it a patch for Redmine core? It looks like a patch for some plugin.

As far as I can tell it's a patch to the core's /projects/settings/_members.rhtml partial inside a Redmine plugin (redmine_smile), thus overloading the core's partial with the modified one. With that in mind I created a patch file against current trunk (<u>r16111</u>) which I hereby attach. Please note that I haven't tested any of this code, it's just a copy-paste of the patch in note 7 (which at maximum is against <u>r4719</u>) against current trunk. I quickly scanned the code and think that it should be working at current Redmine codebase though.
