<p>See: http://www.redmine.org/boards/2/topics/31188, also reported in other forum threads and here.</p> <p>The problem is due to the fact that String#[] changed between ruby 1.8 and 1.9. In 1.8 x[0] would return a fixnum representing the character, while it returned the character itself in 1.9 (1.8 doc, 1.9 doc). It's easily explained by the unicode support improvements in 1.9 and the fact that a single 1.9 character can map to multiple codepoints.</p> <p>The easiest workaround is to let the code as is for 1.8 but only take the first codepoint above (unicode strings can have multiple codepoints per character...).</p>
