<p>It would be very useful to temporarily be able to get rid of the menu and sidebar and see the content only. This could be done by being able to switch the content area to fullscreen using HTML5 browser support.</p> <p>In newer browsers such as Chrome 15, Firefox 10, Safari 5.1, IE 10 this is possible.
