Description

The maximum count of the columns in the [RedmineTimelogReport](#) is 100.
But there isn't any message about it.
So, a user may make a mistake during a time control if a number of time steps exceeds 100.

Steps to reproduce:

- 1. go to the Report
- 2. choose "Date range: all": SearchTimelog.png
- 3. choose "Details: days": TimeLogReport.png
- 4. choose "Add: Project"

Despite the projects in Redmine have more than 100 active days, the number of day columns will be 100 and the Total in the bottom row will be insufficient.

I suppose, that the relevant message about 100-limit is needed.
