<b>Description</b> If I'm logged in to Redmine and have files attached to a ticket or document, I can copy the URL to this file. If I drop this URL to my browser address bar, I get an HTTP 200 header and can download the file immediately.  But if I drop this URL to any other program where I not have logged in yet, I receive also a HTTP 200 header.  It would be very nice to receive a HTTP 401 header, if the request is redirected to the login screen due to no valid user session.
