The plan already set out by this plugin would provide the basic functionality.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Provide a cron like interface for timing notifications - alternatively provide a service that can be run manually which will action the waiting notifications</li><li>• User configurable queries to create notifications based on user requirements</li><li>• (option) customization format</li><li>• Can be used on a 'per-project' basis to provide flexibility for project managers</li></ul>
