<p>As of 2.4.0 the issues in the Gantt will be sorted by start date instead of lft/rgt (implementation of #7335).</p> <p>In my opinion - as an extension of that - it would be very helpful if there was an option in the Redmine settings where the user/admin can configure which kind of sorting shall be used to display the issues in the Gantt (either by lft/rgt or by start date).</p> <p>May it be possible to implement that?</p>
