Description

Right now, to use Redmine.pm, both repository and Redmine project identifier must be same. However, there is a case that both identifier/name are different. To make it work, attached file is the changes I made to Redmine.pm on Redmine2.3.1.

Simply, I added a RedmineProjectId field to define the redmine project id. If this field is written in configuration file, use it for \$project_id.
