A permission 'edit issue planning' can be added which allows or disallows the possibility to edit following fields: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Priority</li><li>- Target version</li><li>- Start and due date</li><li>- Estimated time</li><li>- % Done</li></ul>			
These fields are currently frequently abused by reporters and should only be filled in by the developers of a project. Otherwise, reporters can pollute the issue overviews, like demonstrated by the current redmine roadmap.
