Description			
<p>Links generated by the wiki are invalid when they contain something that could be an email. For example, this : <code>http://foo@www.bar.com</code> is transformed to <code>http://www.foo@bar.com</code> and rendered as this http://foo@www.bar.com in a web browser.</p> <p>I observed this problem by using hg fetch that generates commit messages like : Automated merge with <code>https://login@hg.foo.com/project</code>. Here is a patch that solves the problem and a unit test. The code come from http://dev.rubyonrails.org/changeset/7516. The only limitation of this solution is in that case : <code>http://foo@bar.com foo@bar.com</code> where only the first link is detected. I did not found the magic regexp. Maybe this could be solved with some lookbehind but the syntax is not supported on ruby 1.8.</p>
