<p>In migrate_from_trac.rake, there is this code:</p> <pre>name =~ /(.*)(\s+\w+)?/ fn = \$1.strip ln = (\$2 '-').strip</pre> <p>The regular expression breaking up name is wrong. (.*?) will match the whole string, so the entire name is set to \$1, so the entire name gets assigned to fn, and ln is blank.</p> <p>The attached patch fixes that. Also, I ran into one case where the name was empty, so \$1.strip threw an exception. I fixed that too with the attached patch.</p> <p>Related to #14567</p>
