Click the pencil next to the h3 to edit that section.</p> <p>Expected:</p> <p>The editor should displ</p> <pre>h3. Hi</pre> <pre>lorem ipsum</pre> <p>Actual:</p> <p>The editor displays the h5 section.</p> <p>Notes:</p> <p>Probably because the h5 is not dynamically assigned a pencil button like the other headers are.</p> <p>Probably applies to h6 and h7 (if there is an h7) as well.</p>
