| <p>The MercurialAdapter code grabs changeset details by shelling out, asking hg for the logs, and parsing the results. It stuffs values into a hash, changeset, and uses that to create a Revision object.</p> <p>Line 94 of mercurial_adapter.rb has this call:</p> <pre>changeset[:files].split.collect</pre> <p>but not there is no assurance that it will have a value (least not in my hg repo), leading to an exception because "split" is called on nil.</p> <p>Adding a call to 'to_s' seems to fix this (again, line 94):</p> <pre>:paths => changeset[:files].to_s.split.collect{ path {:action => 'X', :path => "/"#{path}"}}</pre> | | | |
