<p>Our organization just migrated all the data from another ticket system using the RESTful API, which means we have one day with insane activity logs (+6000 tickets, +40000 activity log entries).</p> <p>The problem is, the only option in Administration-&gt;Settings allows limiting the number of days for activity display, but not the limitation of raw numbers to be displayed on one page : in this instance, even "1 day of activity" will generate a giant query that will eat all the memory on the server.</p> <p>It seems the Activity page does not have a pagination option ("Page X of Y", "Display N entries per page" ; as would be the case on an Issues listing page).</p> <p>Would it be possible to consider adding this feature to fix this problem?</p>
