Is this feature something that can be tweaked from the user's or system's settings menu? Maybe it just includes the previous assignee in the notification list if the criteria listed in the **Select actions for which email notifications should be sent** list are met?

For example we have our system setup to only send email notifications when a new issue is created (Issue added) a comment is made (Note added). When the assignee is changed and comment is *not* made to the ticket no email notifications are sent. If a comment *is* made, then the previous assignee *does* get a copy of the email as if they were still the assignee.

Is this expected behavior for this feature?
