<p>I'd expect the date filters in the <a href="#">issue REST API</a> to work with date time values as well as with dates. I wanted to filter for issues updated after a specific time. Using the date time filter</p> <pre>unencoded: updated_on=&gt;=2013-12-29T17:17:33 URL-encoded: updated_on=%3e%3d2013-12-29%2017%3a17%3a33</pre> <p>in the <a href="#">ISO 8601</a> format yields the same internal server error as using the date time format used for the <code>updated_on</code> node returned by another successful query:</p> <pre>&lt;updated_on&gt;Sun Jan 03 12:08:41 +0100 2010&lt;/updated_on&gt;</pre> <p>Related issues:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <a href="#">#8842</a></li><li>• <a href="#">#10402</a></li></ul>
