<p>I have been unable to configure the email truncation settings using a regular expression. I am not the only one having this issue, see #11684, specifically the note:</p> <p>"</p> <p>Etienne Massip wrote:</p> <p>Why not simply fill the Truncate emails after one of these lines accordingly in the Administration/Settings/Incoming mails tab?</p> <p>Well to be honest, I could not figure out how to get that to work using a regular expression, maybe some better documentation would provide useful for this part."</p> <p>If users are writing a patch because they can't work out how to use a built in function, then there is an issue with the documentation.</p> <p>The RedmineReceivingEmails page says "(It is also possible to allow regex to be truncated, e.g. http://www.redmine.org/issues/5864)"</p> <p>I tried .* and also ././ to try and test if it was working at all. The whole email still got through.</p>
