<b>Description</b> <p>Currently I don't like the associated revisions block in the issue tracker. It is great to reference issues from a commit but some things are imo quite annoying.</p> <p>If you have an issue and there are no associated revisions the comments to this issue are as wide as your monitor. When you reference this issue from a commit you suddenly have two columns and the comments have 50% of the your monitor's width. This behaviour sucks because every code block (with pre tags) in the first few comments becomes unreadable!</p> <p>My suggestion is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Place this associated revisions block above (or below) the comments of an issue.</li><li>• Make this block expandable with a little button (like the filters).</li></ul>
