It will be very useful to have option to send notifications on assignee change, under "Issue updated" section.

When "Issue updated" is selected, Redmine mailing is too noisy on busy projects. Users claimed it was spamming too much. When "Issue updated" is not selected, the new assignee does not receive information about what he has to work on. Complaints arise again :). The best way to resolve this problem would be to enable "Assignee updated" notifications, while keeping uninteresting "70% to 80% progress" changes quiet.
