| <p>We have used Redmine for several years now with great success. Setting up a new server I installed Redmine on Tomcat. We are using the Apache WEB server as front-end with the jk Apache Tomcat Connector to simplify the configuration. The problem we have encountered is that the Redmine performance deteriorate with time (just a few hours use) and accessing issues results randomly in Internal error 500.
