<p>Hi, it would be really nice to have ability to set default time zone (for newly created users) somewhere in redmine admin. Configurable timezone can prepopuate this filed - big timesaver!</p> <p>PS: also it can be done via detecting current browser's timezone (not sure if this is possible), but the first solution will be easier, IMHO.</p>
