<p>We have an environment where my username for svn:// access is "Surname" while my LDAP account is "surname", with different passwords.</p> <p>As soon as I configure the access to svn:// with my username and password while my Redmine account is configured as LDAP account, noone is able to login with LDAP accounts anymore and all repositories that use my useraccount to gather the revisions do not work anymore.</p> <p>I am not sure if using both with the same casing works better, should I test that? What else can I do to help?</p>
