<p>We are having issues with Redmine email not being sent.</p> <p>We have found that a workaround to our issue is to update mailer.rb to explicitly state who the mail is from. For example, we have added the highlighted lines below:</p> <pre>def account_information(user, password)   set_language_if_valid user.language   @user = user   @password = password   @login_url = url_for(:controller =&gt; 'account', :action =&gt; 'login')   f = "Redmine &lt;#{Setting.mail_from}&gt;"   mail :to =&gt; user.mail,   :from =&gt; f,   :subject =&gt; I(:mail_subject_register, Setting.app_title) end</pre> <p>We needed to make a similar change in all methods that send out an email. It's not clear to us that this is the correct fix - perhaps there is a setting somewhere that we have missed?</p> <p>We did not see this problem in redmine 2.3.1, but it appeared after upgrading to 2.5.0.</p>
