Description <p>Notification plugins like zulip-redmine-plugin seem to use the controller_issues_edit_after_save hook. It doesn't look like this hook gets triggered when I mention or close an issue in a commit (e.g. "fixes #whatever" in a commit message), so we don't get notified.</p> <p>Should this hook be getting triggered in this case, or is there a general "issue changed" hook we could use?</p>
