## Description

Notification plugins like <u>zulip-redmine-plugin</u> seem to use the controller\_issues\_edit\_after\_save hook. It doesn't look like this hook gets triggered when I mention or close an issue in a commit (e.g. "fixes #whatever" in a commit message), so we don't get notified.

Should this hook be getting triggered in this case, or is there a general "issue changed" hook we could use?
