<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Someone posts a patch.</li><li>2. Someone else :<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. reads the issue.</li><li>2. views the attached file using the diff viewer.</li><li>3. clicks on a link "quote for comment".</li><li>4. selects relevant lines and comments it.</li></ol></li></ol>			
This ability helps the patch reviewing process.			
If possible, there should be one check box per patch hunk and a link or button (or two : top, bottom) to quote selected hunks.
