Description I configured Redmine to use markdown for text input. On my main wiki page, I added a link: [API] (api) Which renders to: <code>API</code> But when I'm on the main page, it points to `projects/PROJECT/api` instead of `projects/PROJECT/wiki/api`, thus giving me a 404 when clicked.
