Starting October 26, 2014 Russia is changing its time zones again. All of Russia will move back one hour, except:			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Udmurtia and Samara Oblast will remain on UTC+04:00 (thus reinstating Samara Time)</li><li>• Kemerovo Oblast will remain on UTC+07:00</li><li>• Zabaykalsky Krai will move back two hours to UTC+08:00</li><li>• Magadan Oblast will move back two hours to UTC+10:00</li><li>• Chukotka Autonomous Okrug and Kamchatka Krai will remain on UTC+12:00 (thus reinstating Kamchatka Time)</li></ul>			
For example, Moscow will move from UTC+4 back to UTC+3 it used before 2011.
