Description Hi, Recently I updated all my projects checking "Inherit members" in order to make our life easier when you have to assign groups and roles to members. In my scenario I have a main project and by heritage I have the rest of the projects. Case 1: If you try to create and edit an issue in the main project all are updated smoothly. Case 2: If you try to create and edit an issue in a 4 level project heritage the performance becomes in a terrible slow updating. Note: I can't reproduce this problem when a user has admin rights.
