<p>When trying to use the rdm-mailhandler.rb script mentioned in http://www.redmine.org/projects/redmine/wiki/RedmineReceivingEmails , I hit a slight problem with internal certificates and the fact that the Ruby Net::HTTP class specifies a non-existing bundle file that has to be overridden.</p> <p>I added my own code to override the bundle from the Net::HTTP instance, via a command line option.</p> <p>The included patch adds the option parsing, and passing to Net::HTTP.</p>
