<b>Description</b> When trying to use the rdm-mailhandler.rb script mentioned in <a href="http://www.redmine.org/projects/redmine/wiki/RedmineReceivingEmails">http://www.redmine.org/projects/redmine/wiki/RedmineReceivingEmails</a> , I hit a slight problem with internal certificates and the fact that the Ruby Net::HTTP class specifies a non-existing bundle file that has to be overridden.  I added my own code to override the bundle from the Net::HTTP instance, via a command line option. The included patch adds the option parsing, and passing to Net::HTTP.
