Description Using Redmine Java API library: User user = rmf.getUserManager.getCurrentuser; user.setFirstName("new name"); rmf.getUserManager.update(user); Error: BadAuthentication. I believe this is because Redmine requires authorization for "update user" action, which requires admin privileges. What it should do instead is to check permissions basing on resources . In this example user should be able to change his/her own details.
