<p>I would like the ability to be able to set specific user account information fields to read-only. This will be particularly useful for when using LDAP to handle the user's account &amp; details.</p> <p>Currently, I am using LDAP to handle user account creation and log-ins. This works great, but one thing I have noticed is that even when using LDAP, it allows the user to change any of their user account information fields.</p> <p>This could be a good thing, but in my case, when users start changing their login or their email address and parts of my application/system requires their login and/or their email address to be the same as whats in LDAP, it is horrible.</p> <p>Also, another problem is when the user is able to change their email address to whatever they like, and they enter a wrong address (whether purposefully or not). This causes the email notifications to not work correctly for things like project News because one of the member email addresses is invalid.</p>
