<p>I created a custom query in a project with a role that permit of course custom queries. In the query I checked the "for all projects" checkbox.</p> <p>After the creation, I'm not able anymore to edit the query; every time I try to change it I've a 403 forbidden error.</p> <p>I think this is a regression, in fact with old 2.5.1 redmine version all worked fine.</p>
