<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Patches 0001 and 0002: Replaces all uses of <code>image_tag()</code> to render icons with <code>icon-*</code> definitions. This makes it possible to replace all these icons with Font-based icons, e.g. FontAwesome.• Patch 0003: A unimportant change to use the PDF icon for "Also available in PDF" links• Patch 0004: Updates pagination to use <code></code> and <code></code> to render the pagination part• Patch 0005: Building on top of patch 0004, changes pagination to a GitHub like design that also looks and feels nice in responsive mode			
Based on r14881 , everything passes "rake test" and is tested in Firefox 42, Safari 9 and Chrome 46.
