Here how it works:</p> <p>If a changeset refers to an Issue that has not a linked repository, it looks for an upper lever project, to see if there is a repository. If it has, changeset is linked to that Issue;</p> <p>If a project has no repository linked and is a subproject, it looks for an upper level project. If there is there, it uses that repository so if you click on revision number linked to related Issue, it shows correctly changes made.</p> <p>Hope this helps, Andrea</p>
