<p>A issue was introduced in <a href="#">r1963</a> where application.css now pushes the hisotry entries past the revisions (ie, clear: both). This is a huge problem for some of our issues where we have 5 or more commits - the issue comments are pushed so far off the screen that you're not necessarily sure there are any.</p> <p>Disabling the rule in application.css allows the history to wrap normally.</p> <p>issue.png</p>
