<p>Hello,</p> <p>if I send an email with .txt file encoded in ISO 8859-2, it's received from the mailbox and saved to /files, but the encoding is different (some characters are lost). I think this is originally caused by the utf-8 header added by email clients. In my opinion attachments shouldn't be reencoded.
