<p>In Administration / Issue Tracking, setting start / due dates to be calculated from subtasks allows to manually set a start date / due date on a parent task even if it has subtasks associated.</p> <p>It would be nice, if no start / due date are explicitly set on the parent task, to display, on the parent task, the min start date / max due date from all of its subtasks.</p> <p>We can already do that with the estimated time, and it aggregates the estimated time from subtasks + the parent task.</p> <p>This calculation is done only if no start / due dates are set on the parent task.</p> <p>What do you think ?</p>
