<b>Description</b> <p>The project issue page under "redmine/projects/[ID]/issues" has only core fields and custom fields enabled for the project, custom fields enabled for subprojects are missing in both filters and columns.</p> <p>This is a problem as does not allow to build project summary queries when projects are organized in hierarchy. The very top level projects are just a grouping projects where no issues can be created, no trackers enabled.
